Log in with your email and password (reset if you forgot). It is important that all volunteers and club leaders enroll now. Each club needs to have 2 fully screened level 2 volunteers. Bradford County 4-H covers the fees for background screenings.

All 4-H Youth may enroll after September 1st at <u>4-H online</u> For this upcoming 4-H year, membership fees remain \$20. This fee applies to youth ages 8-18, so Cloverbuds and adults are exempt from this fee.

From this fee, \$10 goes to the state 4-H office to support the many excellent state programs offered and to cover the insurance for each member. The remainder of the \$10 comes back to our county program.

The 4-H plate voucher can be purchased at any time. To purchase you just need your Driver License number. You can also purchase a voucher as a gift for someone as long as you have the recipients Driver License number.

<u>3,000 vouchers must be sold in order to be produced!</u>

100% of the \$25 annual plate fee will support the Florida 4-H Foundation for the following statewide programs: Camping, Legislature, University and competitive event participation. The total voucher cost is \$33 after additional fees'.
