- ✿ Opportunities for youth to earn recognition and develop life skills leading to long-term impacts.



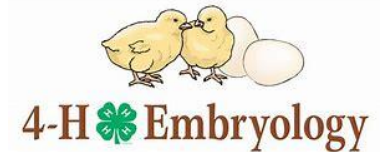
Orange County Supported School Enrichment Projects:

- ✿ 4-H Embryology: 4-H utilizes the Embryology; Hatching Classroom Projects to provide background information and activities for teachers to deliver hands-on life science education. The curriculum is correlated to the National Science Education Standards and includes such concepts as scientific inquiry, characteristics of organisms, life cycles of organisms, and organisms and their environments. The 4-H program will provide an electronic version of the curriculum, loaner incubators, and assist with obtaining fertile eggs.
