





## 4-H Gingerbread House Challenge

In the spirit of the upcoming season and to encourage youth to use their creativity, engineering, problem solving and team building skills, the St. Johns County 4-H Program will once again host a gingerbread house challenge. 4-H youth may enter as an individual, as a team of 2, 3, or 4 (same or multi-age) or as a 4-H Club. Read the guidelines below for detailed information.

## **4-H Gingerbread House Challenge Guidelines**

- 1. All visible parts of your house creation must be made of edible materials. You may however, use non-edible materials on the interior/underside for stability.
- 2. The base must be sturdy, easy to move, and may **not** exceed 20" by 20".
- 3. Entries must be delivered to the St. Johns County Extension Office (3125 Agricultural Center Drive, St. Augustine, FL 32092) by **4pm on Friday, December 1**st, **2023**. Late entries will not be judged.
- 4. Exhibitors who make arrangements to donate and deliver their house to a local nursing home, hospital or shelter can count this as community service on their 4-H Clover Awards.
- 5. Houses will be judged on theme, presentation, structure, and inclusion of the 4-H clover. For club entries, the house theme must relate to their 4-H club or project. Houses will be on display during Craft Night in the St. Johns County Extension Office Auditorium on Tuesday, December 5<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm.
- 6. Exhibitors can pick up their houses from the St. Johns County Extension Office starting December 6<sup>th</sup>
- 7. Entry form must accompany all gingerbread house submissions.
- 8. Gingerbread house must include a 4-H clover.
