Potassium Deficiency in Hay Fields can Enhance Disease Issues

At the end of June, a Jackson County, FL rancher noticed something strange about his hay field. The field was gradually turning yellow and was not growing well. Typically plants turn yellow as the result of a nitrogen deficiency, but this field had been fertilized for hay production. Upon inspection, the leaves were yellow with dark brown spots, as in the photo below. There were also green clumps scattered across the field... This infection, however, was much different than Dollar Spot, so Dr. Ann Blount, UF/IFAS Forage Specialist, was contacted to set up a field visit. Late Summer Temperatures Shorten Gestation Length of Fall-calvers

Each year in August, it is time for an important reminder. Fall-calving season is here. In fact, the start of the fall calving season often begins before some producers expect it. The target date for the beginning of fall calving very often is September 1. Most printed gestation tables predict that calving will take place 283 days (some 285 days) after artificial insemination or natural breeding. Cows and heifers that gestate in hot weather will often calve a few days earlier than expected.
