Weekly Descriptions

CRAFTY CREATIONS WEEK June 10 - 13 Ages 6-12. A full week of basic arts and crafts. Activities will focus on creativity, imagination, and self-expression. Crafts will be designed to improve fine motor skills and teach basic crafting techniques with various media. All artists welcome.

ANIMAL ADVENTURE WEEK June 17 – 20 Ages 6-12. Activities will explore all different types of animals. Campers will learn about the classification of animals, animal habitats, migration, and wildlife ecology. Educational opportunities for all ages. Live animals will be present throughout the week. ***Please list any animal allergies*.**

FARM ADVENTURE WEEK June 24- 27 – Ages 6-12. Programming will center on where food originates, livestock, and different types of farming. Activities will focus on products local to Florida. Animals will be discussed as food. Live animals will be present throughout the week. ***Please note that meats, fruits, spices, herbs, nuts, soy, and milk will be used in these activities. **Please list any animal allergies****

BEYOND THE CRAYON WEEK (advanced crafts) July 8-11 - Ages 8-13 ONLY. This craft week will offer more advanced crafting techniques including clay sculpting and painting. Activities will focus on creativity, imagination, and self-expression using various techniques and media. Campers will work with a local artist to create their own canvas painting.

FUN WITH FOOD WEEK July 15-18 – Ages 8 to 13 ONLY. Activities will focus on cooking skills, safety, and nutrition. Campers will have the opportunity to learn grilling techniques and will be introduced to the 4-H Food Challenge Contest curriculum. Family and Consumer Science Agent, Samantha Kennedy will help guide the week of cooking activities. ***Please note that meats, fruits, spices, herbs, nuts, soy, and milk will be used in these activities.***

ARCHERY WEEK July 24th – July 22-25 Ages 8 to 13 ONLY Campers will be introduced to the sport of archery using Genesis compound bows. Activities will focus on learning hand and eye coordination, proper archery techniques, sportsmanship, and improving self-confidence.

- **For current members for the 2023-2024 4-H year**, use your log- in information. You will find the camps listed under **Events** in the left-hand column of the page. You will register for each week of camp individually. Please check camp names and dates to assure you are registering for the correct camp week.
- Once you have registered for camps, you will receive an email stating your request has been received.
- A \$50.00 nonrefundable deposit is required for each week your child is registered. The deposit must be paid within 5 business days. Your child will not be approved and registered until the deposit/s have been received.
- All payments must be made at the Wakulla County Extension Office, 84 Cedar Ave, Crawfordville, FL. The office is open from 8:00 Am to 4:30 PM for payments. There is a drop-box for after hours. Please make checks. We can except cash, check or credit cards. Please make checks payable to Wakulla County Extension.
- **All Non-4-H members will need to create an account as a participant.** If you have previously attended camp, you will need to use your prior login information.
