Similar to a stall decorating at the State show, we're encouraging our Area members to showcase their project. One OVERALL County will receive the award, but youth INDIVIDUAL scores will be used to calculate the Area North Horseman Award.

Posters should be standard size (22x28) or similar and safely adhered to the front of the horse's stall.

In the case of a tie, 2 county youth will explain and speak about their display to a judge. An additional of up to 5 points will be allotted for this speaking component. The county with the highest average of points will be the winner.
