1. This program is open to all Bradford County 4-H members.
2. Items must be baked by the 4-H member, with assistance from a parent/guardian if needed.
3. Judging will be by category and age division. Items will be judged primarily on taste, but also on presentation, creativity, texture, consistency, and technical skill. While our judges do have a rubric to follow, please note that judging can be subjective.
4. Age Divisions are as follows:
 - **Cloverbuds** (ages 5-7) - may enter but will only receive participation ribbons.
 - **Juniors** (ages 8-10)
 - **Intermediates** (ages 11-13)
 - **Seniors** (ages 14-18)
5. Categories are as follows:
 - **Appetizer:** A savory dish, often bite-sized or shareable. Can include baked dips, tarts, stuffed pastries, etc.
 - **Bread:** A baked product made from flour, water, and leavening agents, ranging from soft rolls and crusty loaves to sweet quick breads.
 - **Cake:** A sweet, baked pastry confection made with flour, sugar, eggs, and leavening agents. Can include cupcakes.
 - **Candy:** Sweet confections made by cooking sugar with other ingredients like chocolate, nuts, or flavorings. Can include fudge, truffles, brittles, etc.
 - **Cookies:** Small, sweet, hand-held baked goods, typically made with flour, sugar, and butter, and shaped as drop, cutout, or pressed treats.
 - **Pie:** A baked pastry dish with a sweet or savory filling encased in a crust, typically served in slices and associated with tradition and comfort. Can include cobblers.
6. **ALL ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE RECIPE CARDS including at minimum the name of recipe and the ingredients used.**
