

The date for submission of Club Mini grants has been extended and is now **Nov 1**. These grants can be used to help support special club projects, educational programs, & field trips or to provide supplies, equipment, or other club needs. They can also be submitted for leadership development, community service, or hands-on experiences for club members and/or the community. Clubs can receive up to \$250 per program year. 4-H Specialty Plate

4-H Specialty Plate pre-sale vouchers are NOW AVAILABLE **ONLINE** or at your local tag office location. The voucher can be purchased any time; you do not have to wait for your renewal period. To purchase you just need your Driver License number. You can also purchase a voucher as a gift from someone with the recipient's DL#. You can even get vouchers for your camper, trailer, and any other Florida license plates you have—show your 4-H pride everywhere you go!

3,000 vouchers must be sold by the NEW deadline in 2024. Once the minimum is met, the plate will be produced.

100% of the \$25 annual plate fee will support the Florida 4-H Foundation for the following statewide programs: Camping, Legislature, University, and competitive event participation.

With administrative processing fees the total voucher cost is ~\$33.
