SPA 6 STENIS

Worms break down food scraps and leave behind a valuable garden supplement: their castings (or worm poop)! Worm castings are a nutrient-rich soil amendment that can be used just like any other type of compost. Since worms only eat kitchen scraps, vermicomposting is an ideal method of composting. Worm farms are small, easy to manage, and can be kept indoors if needed.


