

4-H homeschool youth are invited to participate in the national <u>Trig-Star</u> math and trigonometry competition sponsored locally by the UF Geomatics Extension program and nationally by the National Society of Professional Surveyors. This competition connects youth interested in competing with local surveying industry professionals to learn about how surveyors apply trigonometry in their careers and helps prepare students for the competition. Youth who have covered trigonometry concepts, including the Law of Sines and Law of Cosines, can compete in a national competition with only a few hours of time commitment. State winners receive cash prizes and compete at the national level. Any participant is eligible to apply for the Trig-Star college scholarship if they pursue a surveying and mapping degree.
