




6x 6 foot Butterfly Garden

Plant List

- 4 Native Porterweed Stachytarpheta jamaicensis
- 4 Wild Ruellia caroliniensis
- 5 Pentas Pentas lanceolata
- 4 Pineland Heliotrope Heliotropium polyphyllium
- 1 Passion Vine Passiflora incarnata, P. suberosa, or P. incarnata x cinnicata 'Incense'
- 1 White Twine Vine Sarcostemma clausum

Hardscape

- Mulch
- Corner trellis of (2) 2 x 6ft. Lattice and posts
- Birdbath or something of architectural interest for the circular area

Garden Placement Basics

- Full Sun setting is best
- Select a protected area away from traffic or recreation but convenient to the house or patio for viewing pleasure
- Close to a water source for establishment ease and for bird bath maintenance
- Place taller plants in north-facing position so they will not shade the other plants during the day or in center of bed if not bordered by a fence or home
