


Celebrating National 4-H Week

Even though Floridians do not witness many of the changes caused by the seasons here in our home state, sweater weather, falling leaves, clocks falling back and pumpkin spice can be found throughout the United States this time of year. These are just a few staples of the Fall season.

Fall, is one of the 4 seasons and is the transition between summer and winter. During the 1500's, this season was called "harvest" as it was the time of year when farmers would gather their crops and prepare for winter storage. Although the season has evolved over the years, many of the same events still take place each year. Once people began moving away from farms and into cities to work in factories, the season began being known as fall or autumn.

Some of the significant changes you will notice during this season include:

- -The color change and falling of the leaves due to the short amounts of sunlight and plants no longer producing their own food. Leaves change from green to red to golden yellow and finally a vivid orange before falling off completely.
- -Shorter days and longer nights caused by daylight savings time resulting in less daylight during this season.
- -Mild temperatures are more likely causing this to be the perfect time for outdoor activities.

FLORIDA STATE FAIR Ethics Seminar

The Youth Livestock Show Ethics and Animal Care Workshop is designed to educate students of the mandatory procedures and requirements that will be in effect for the Florida State Fair.

Certifications are valid for three (3) Fair seasons, not 3 calendar years.

The Charlotte County Fair believes that every youth exhibitor should receive proper training and information for raising and showing a youth animal project. With this in mind, the Youth Livestock Show Ethics and Animal Care Training Program was developed by the Florida State Fair and is required for all exhibitors 8 years old and older.

Due to the COVID-19 situation, the expiration date for the 2018 Certifications will be extended until May 2021. For the 2020/2021 Fair Season, Certification Numbers starting with 18, 19, 20, and 21 are valid.

4-H SWINE CLUB

It's that time of year, where our members have been busy selecting their new project animal for the 2021 fairs. They have spent a lot of time researching, learning what to look for in a market hog project and have been talking to breeders from all across Florida and all the way to lowa in hopes to select a blue ribbon pig. They will start with a pig that weighs around 65-100lbs and by fair time their animal should

weigh between 240-280lbs. They will have a lot of work in the upcoming months as they learn how to feed and care for their animal as well as train their pig how to properly drive in the show ring. Many of our members will also be competing in the Florida Jr Swine Circuit this winter to gain experience before they show at the fair. The circuit consist of several shows across the state between November thru January where they can earn points to compete for overall awards and have the opportunity to compete against other exhibitors across the state. We also have a couple of members who also in January will be competing in Perry, Ga at the Winter Type Conference where they will be competing at the National level against other exhibitors from around the country. In the next few months our club will be learning showmanship skills and how to market their projects to potential buyers.
