

TIPPING ETIQUETTE



Tipping is a sign of gratitude for good service, whether you're ordering from your phone, getting food delivered, or dining in at a restaurant. Here's what you need to know:

Dine-in Restaurants

Full-service Restaurants: The standard tip is 15-20% of the bill, based on the quality of service and overall dining experience.

Buffets or Fast-Casual: A tip of 10% is customary for staff assistance, like clearing dishes and refilling drinks.



When not to Tip

Non-Service Transactions: Tipping is not expected for purchases like groceries or retail items where service is not directly involved like in store pick up.



Mobile Ordering

Coffee Shops and Cafes: Consider tipping 10-20% of the order total, depending on the complexity of your order and the quality of service.

Restaurants and Food Apps: For table service or app-based orders, a 15-20% tip is customary to show appreciation for the staff's efforts.

Gratitude in Non-Monetary Ways

Saying "Thank You": A genuine thank-you to the service provider, whether in person or through a note, is always appreciated.

Positive Reviews: Leaving positive reviews for great service can boost morale and help others find exceptional businesses.



Home Delivery

Food Delivery: It's common to tip 15-20% for food deliveries, recognizing the convenience and effort of the delivery driver.

Package Delivery: While not mandatory, tipping package delivery drivers \$1-\$5 per package during the holiday season is a thoughtful gesture.
