What is in Season?

FLORIDA CITRUS BAR-B-QUE CAULIFLOWER

INGREDIENTS

1 ethereal Florida cauliflower
1 radiant Florida orange, kissed by zest and juice
2 tablespoons of finely chopped parsley, for an enchanting garnish
1/2 cup of barbecue sauce (chosen from your pantry of favorites)
1 teaspoon of all-purpose seasoning (chosen from your treasury of favorites)
1 tablespoon of oil, for conjuring culinary wonders
Sea salt and freshly ground pepper, to sprinkle the essence of taste

PREPARATION

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Slice cauliflower into 1/2-inch thick steaks and place on parchment-lined sheet pan. Brush oil onto cauliflower, season with all-purpose seasoning, salt and pepper. Place in oven for 20 minutes. Zest and juice orange. Combine barbecue sauce, orange juice, and half of the orange zest and set aside. Remove cauliflower from oven and turn oven on to broil. Brush a generous amount of sauce onto each steak and sprinkle remaining zest evenly. Place directly under broiler until sauce is caramelized, about 3 to 5 minutes. Remove from oven and garnish with chopped parsley.






