Club Purpose

The purpose of the Duval 4-H Hippology Club is to prepare youth for 4-H Equine Knowledge contests, including Hippology, Horse Judging, Quiz Bowl, and Communications. Members will also have opportunities to participate in educational events such as Horse Judging School and other 4-H-sponsored activities. Through the club, youth will gain hands-on experience and knowledge in a variety of horse-related topics, including anatomy, nutrition, health care, breeds, and management practices.

Club Projects

The Hippology 4-H Club completes the Hippology Project, which is designed to enhance members' understanding of Equine Science. The project encourages youth to expand their knowledge in areas such as horse anatomy, nutrition, health, breeds, and management and more. In addition to Hippology, members can complete complementary projects including Horse Judging, Public Speaking, and Leadership.
