

# WHAT IS SOIL BLOCKING?

- Using molds to form wet soil into blocks that hold their shape
- Seeds are planted directly into the blocks
- No containers are used



## Why would I want to make soil blocks?

- It's fun
- No need for pots
- Save \$\$
- Healthier roots
- Less transplant shock
- Transplant difficult seedlings



### Is this just for vegetables?

 No! It's for any seed you want to start!







## Make your soil mix



1/3 DRAINAGE





## Soil Mix Options

SUBSTRATE PEAT, COIR

DRAINAGE
PERLITE,
VERMICULITE,
RICE HULLS

NUTRIENTS
FERTILIZER,
ORGANIC
AMENDMENTS







How much water?

Enough that when you squeeze a handful, water drips out

#### Soil Blocks or Molds

- Square style with plunger
- Round style with plunger
- DIY tubing














### Making soil blocks

PRESS AND PACK
SOIL MIX INTO
MOLD

CAREFULLY PLUNGE
BLOCK ONTO RIMMED
TRAY


## Planting soil blocks

# Watering soil blocks after seedlings sprout

WATER FROM THE BOTTOM





INTO LARGER
BLOCK, POT OR
GROUND

## What are some downsides to soil blocks?

- It can be a mess
- May take some experimenting
- Watering can be a bit more challenging
- Transplanting can be a bit more
  - challenging

#### Keys to success

- Use at least some peat
- Fine texture
- More water than normal
- Mix day before planting to allow good hydration
