CLUB AND CATEGORY BOOTHS

- Extra booths may be available on a first come, first served basis and will not be judged.
- Booth setup is to be done by YOUTH ONLY. Adults may assist in moving items into the building but NOT in the setup of booths. Booths not set up by youth will be disqualified.
- Clubs are responsible for providing a gate at booths to prevent booths from being tampered with during the duration of the fair.
- Clubs are responsible for the décor and shelving of their booths. All booths must be covered and must display "4-H" and/or display an official 4-H clover to be judged.
- The last day to set up your booth is Tuesday October 15. Remember ALL youth should be accompanied by 2 adults at all times, one of which must be a Level 2 screened volunteer.
- Booths can be assembled at Building 3 during the following times:

INDIVIDUAL SUBMISSIONS

New for 2024Individuals should complete the event registration through 4honline. To do this login to your 4honline profile, select the events tab on the left-hand side of the screen then click the register for a new event button. From there select the 2024 Pensacola Interstate Fair and hit next to begin the registration process. Select all categories you wish to enter, then submit the registration. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. This registration should indicate ALL the submissions for each individual. Register every entry you intend to enter at the time of the fair. For example, if you intend to enter a cupcake, you must select the cupcake entry. You may choose not to bring an entry if you choose, but no substitutes or extras will be allowed.

- All baked goods submissions should be accompanied by a recipe card the same color as summary forms and claim tickets. Please make sure your recipe card is legible and has the correct source for the recipe (grandmother, Paula Deen, etc.) Baked goods display containers can be picked up at the 4-H office.
- Youth will submit their entries for judging at Building 3 where they will be given their submission tags and deliver their submissions to the appropriate table. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IF THE YOUTH DID NOT REGISTER ON 4HONLINE BY OCTOBER 11, 2024. All submissions must be setup at their appropriate booth by 4:00pm Wednesday, October 16.

CONSUMER JUDGING

- Each club can have 3 teams, a Junior, Intermediate and a Senior team, made up of four youth each to compete in consumer judging. Teams are not required to be made up of members of the same club.
- Though youth make up a team by their age category, youth will compete individually in the virtual event on October 12, 2024. Winners will be announced at the November 4-H Council Meeting.
- The top four overall scores are eligible to compete as a team in the North Florida Fair Consumer Judging competition as a team. These youth may choose not to participate in the North Florida Fair. All responsibility and expenses of these youth are the responsibility of the youth themselves.

WINNING SUBMISSIONS AND BOOTHS

- Youth may not retrieve their ribbons until they pick up their items from the fair on October 27.
- Champion Exhibitor awards and remaining ribbons will be distributed at the November 4-H County Council meeting.

FAIR TAKE DOWN

• All individual submissions and club booth items must be removed from Building 3 on the last Sunday of the fair. The building will be open from 9:00am-3:00pm for these items to be retrieved. Anything remaining after 3:00pm will not be saved.
