# 4-H Chick Chain



4-H Chick Chain program is designed to youth learn how to raise baby chicks into mature production pullets. Youth learn responsibility, ethical treatment of animals, biosecurity, record keeping and communications skills.

Youth purchase or hatch pullets during March, 2019, register their project and raise the chicks for 21 weeks. They'll participate in workshops learning how to care for their chicks, show hens and complete project books and participate in a show in September.

# NORTH FLORIDANORTH FLORIDAFAIR 4-H DAYFAIR EXHIBITS

The **78<sup>th</sup>Annual North Florida Fair** starts **November 7<sup>th</sup> thru November 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019.** 

Saturday, November 16<sup>th</sup>, is 4-H Day at the North Florida Fair. The Jefferson County 4-H Club will be taking a bus to the Fair. We will meet at the Jefferson County Extension Office at 10:30 a.m. and return around 5:00 p.m. that afternoon.

Parents, you will need to make arrangements for your child to get home from the Extension Office. If someone other than yourself will be picking up your child, please inform us ahead of time. The cost of transportation this year will be \$2.00, \$1.00 will be refunded back to the child if they return back to the bus on time for departure.

4-Hers will need money for rides and lunch at the Fair. A wrist band can be purchased for \$15.00 from the 4-H Office for all rides on Saturday, 4-H Day. Youth will need extra money for food.

The deadline to purchase wristbands is November 1, 2019.



#### All entries must be accompanied by an Entry Form from the 2019 Fair Book. This Department is open to only bonafide 4-H members in Florida. Each 4-H member will be limited to a total of sixteen (16) exhibits with no more than six (6) exhibits in one class, except for Classes 12 and 15, where members are limited to only one (1) entry and Class 11, limit to three (3) entries.

#### NO LIVE ANIMAL(S) EXHIBITS.

Exhibits are to be expression of what has been learned through 4-H experience. Counties that do not enter group or club projects may not submit more than twentyfive (25). Articles exhibited must have been completed in the past year by the member entering the item(s). If 4-H members wish to exhibit articles not affiliated with their 4-H experiences, they should enter the youth section of the Home Division (Dept. 510). A 4-H exhibit can be one or more items made through a 4-H experience (example: dress, pillow, photograph, collections, canning, etc.)

\*Horticulture (Plants): Should be well groomed for the show. Plants are to be labeled with common name. To get plants ready for show, do the following:

\*Plants and flowers must be arranged in an attractive display (i.e., dish garden or saucer for draining)

\*Photo's: Must be mounted on a non-frame board that may be of 5mm foam board or mat board no larger than 8"X 10". May be in color or black and white. A minimum of three (3) photo's to a maximum of five (5). all photo's should be size 8"X 10".

\*Poetry: Poems can be typed. Only one (1) poem per page is acceptable. Font size should be at least 12 point. Poems must be on 8"X 11" (sheet of paper) and submitted in a plastic sleeve.

Poems will be judged on the following criteria: Effective use of language; Mood intensity; Originality in approach and theme/creativity; Meaningful content.

\*Clothing Construction: Garments must be clean, pressed, and presented on hangers. Entries will be judged based on construction and pressing techniques, appropriate fabric, and design.

\*Sewing: Examples of sewing exhibits include pillows, tote bags, aprons, duffle bags, sewn accessories, and machine quilting.

\*Baked Goods: Will be judged on Monday, November 4<sup>th</sup> that afternoon. Please bring food items to the Jefferson County Office. No items requiring refrigeration will be accepted. Recipe must be included. Foods will be judged on appearance, texture, and flavor.

\*Needlework: Examples of credible needlework exhibits include: crocheting, knitting, embroidery, and hand quilting.

\*Canning: Only standard canning jars should be used. Jars should be clean, polished, and have new rings. Recipe procedures must be included. Examples: pickles, preserves, jams, jellies, fruits, vegetables, and meats may be entered.

\*Crafts: Include: macramé, ceramics, pottery, candles, wreaths, picture frames, holiday ornaments, etc.

\*Hobbies and Collections: Include: Stamps, Coin, leaf, bugs, etc.

\*Architectural Models: Project is designed to allow members to create 3-dimensional models. These models should be constructed using Legos, blocks or similar pieces.

\*Fine Arts: Examples of credible fine arts exhibits include: woodworking, hand made jewelry, paintings, drawings sculpture (wood, metal, clay, etc.) and textile weaving.

\*Graphic Designs: Include 4-H Promotion Posters, Dairy Days Posters, and 4-H Project Posters. Must have a 4-H Clover and/or the words "4-H". Poster must be 14" X 22". (1/2 sheet poster board) all others will be disqualified. Poster may be produced using any medium (watercolor, ink, crayon, collage, etc.)

\*Tabletop Exhibits: Tabletop exhibits may be developed from any of the 4-H Demonstration categories listed in the Florida 4-H Events and Activities Hand**book.** Copies of this book are available from your club leader or local County Extension Office. Free standing, able to withstand the elements, and should measure a MAXIMUM of 36" wide X 36" high. Judged based on effectiveness of message, quality of construction and general appearance, accuracy and appeal of information presented, and creativity. Diorama is an example of a tabletop exhibit.

\*Scrapbooking: One (1) scrapbook page measuring a MINI-MUM of 8" X 10" and a MAXI-MUM of 12" wide X 12" high. Should be related to a 4-H project or activity depicting activities in which 4-H'ers might have participated. Photos should have captions. The page should have appropriate journaling describing the photos.

\*Recycled/Repurposed Clothing: Member designs and sews a wearable garment from previously used materials. The completed garment is different from its original use. Judged on creativity as well as sewing skills. The original garment is not yardage like a bedspread or sheet, but an actual garment.

\*Recycle Arts: Must be made with at least one (1) recycled object (i.e. an item that is being used differently than its original purpose). Must be from recycled or natural environmental material, such as pine cones, sticks, plastics, aluminum cans, newspapers, cardboard, etc. Recycled art can take many forms: 2-dimensional, 3-dimensional, fashion design and accessories, weaving, interactive, mechanical, electronic.

\*For specific requirements of each "Class", please refer to the North Florida Fair Book under 4-H Club Department (Dept. 210).

All 4-H exhibits must be registered (Entry Forms) at the County Extension Office by Thursday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2019. NO REGISTRA-TION WILL BE ACCEPTED AF-TER THAT DATE.

Once the **Entry Forms** are in, you can only replace an item that's in the same **CLASS**.

Your Exhibits are to be finished and ready for tags to be placed on

them.

Here are some answers to frequently asked questions about this event:

4-H Day at LEGOLAND is open to anyone!

Tickets are only good for Saturday, September 14, 2018.

Tickets must be ordered online at least 24 hours before the event- so order your tickets before 11:59 PM on Friday, September 13th.

Youth under the age of 3 are admitted for free.

You do not have to bring your 4-H Membership card; just bring the tickets you print at home generated by the link above. If you have a 4-H t-shirt, please wear it! We would like to see a "sea of green" at LEGOLAND that day.

Tickets do not include admission to the water park unless you buy the combo ticket for \$62.99/person.

You are responsible for your transportation to and from the park, and for making any reservations for overnight accommodations. Many of the hotels in the area offer free shuttle services to and from the park, so ask your hotel concierge. The LEGOLAND Hotel recently opened and is offering some great deals online.

If you are driving to the park, you can purchase preferred parking for \$25.23.

You can also get the LEGOLAND round trip bus transportation for \$5.00. 24 hour advance reservation required. Pick Up at I-Drive 360. Bus stop is at the backside of 8401 International Dr, Orlando, FL 32819 at 9:00am. Arrive 30 minutes prior to departure. Leaves to return at scheduled Park closing.
