



## Miami-Dade county 4-H Summer Programming Scholarships



Youth can only apply once per summer to events below using the Summer Programming Scholarship process. Summer Programming Scholarships uses the Standards of Excellence criteria. Scholarship applications will only be for the following events:

1. Residential Camp
  2. Legislature, or
  3. 4-H University

  - Recipients must achieve the “Silver Clover” level, at a minimum.
  - Amount of scholarship is dependent on amount of youth seeking scholarships for the particular event. Maximum amount for one scholarship will be \$200.00.
  - All events will have a minimum of \$50.00 registration fee which is due 7 (seven) days after registering for the event. Failure to pay the registration fee by the due date forfeits the scholarship amount.
  - Scholarship forms are due no later than the last day of regular registration for the specific events.
  - It is the participant’s responsibility to ensure that the proper forms have been received in the 4-H Office.
