WHAT ARE UTILITIES?

Utilities are essential services that your home, apartment, or business needs to keep comfortable and liveable.

There are two types, public and private owned utilities:

- The private "investor-owned" utilities are for-profit and are subject to state regulations.
- The community owns public utilities and regulates certain areas for environmental and health matters.

Did you know there are 18 Utility Companies in Miami-Dade County, FL, serving a population of 2,702,602 people in an area of 1,899 square miles?

DID YOU KNOW?

The average family of four uses 255 gallons of water a day, 1,785 gallons a week, and 7,650 gallons per month.

Suppose all U.S. households practiced water conservation measures and installed water-saving features such as low-flow showerheads or faucet aerators. Water use would decrease by 30 percent, saving an estimated 5.4 billion gallons per day.

These factors may be adding to your

- Extreme weatherLonger billing period
- A full house (holidays & summer break) Additional equipment (additional fridge, pool, hot tub, "always-on' equipment)
- Duct leaks, water leaks
 Inadequate insulation

TIPS TO HELP LOWER YOUR BILL

- · Energy efficiency assessments: this is often done for free
- Investing in efficiency (includes energy efficient light bulbs, thermostat, etc.)
- Turn off lights when you are not in room, unplug items when not in use.
- Use blinds are drapes to take advantage of the sun's warmth/ block out the sun
