Majestic Palm

Ravanea rivularis

Most often seen as an indoor container plant. The Majestic Palm, also known as Majesty Palm, thrives in warm, humid environments and prefers bright but indirect light. Direct sunlight can scorch the leaves. They prefer high humidity and moist, well-drained soil. Overwatering can cause root rot. Avoid cold drafts or direct heat.

Type: perennial evergreen house plant

USDA hardiness zones: 10 through 11

Uses: indoors; specimen; deck or patio;

container or planter

Origin: not native to North America

Height: 15 to 20 feet **Spread:** 5 to 12 feet

Plant spacing: houseplant

Light requirement: bright, indirect light

Soil tolerances: clay; loam well-drained

Drought tolerance: high

Soil salt tolerances: moderate

Invasive potential: not considered a problem
