NOTES:

- lunch and beverages are provided by school
- students eat outdoors under a covered pavilion
- bathrooms are available, but suggested to bring hand sanitizer
- students will take a post-test prior to eating lunch
- Lab length can be adjusted if your schedule allows, we prefer to do nothing less than 35 minute rotations
- we provide 2 staff members to facilitate each lab
- school should provide a minimum of 1 adult per lab group (minimum 3 adults)
- maximum of 45 students on each field day, be prepared to quickly divide into 3 groups
- entrance fee waiver request letters must be provided to each vehicle and handed to entrance station for the State Park trips
- we visit your classroom for a preparatory presentation prior to each field trip

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
