SCIENCE OF MERENGUES & MACARONS - Learn about the science behind how me- rengue cookies and macarons are made. Instead of paying \$30 for a dozen macarons, learn how to make your own! This is a super fun class that is part chemistry and part cooking for kids who are serious about learning. We will have a combination of classroom

learning and hands-on cooking. We will be learning about the science of foams and their stability which is important for un-derstanding how to make merengue cookies, and the key to making a good macaron is to start with a good merengue. Successful macaron making requires a lot of trial and error and practice. Although we will take kids with no cooking ex-perience, this is an intermediate level baking class. The kids will not only be making merengue cookies and macarons in class, but they will also receive several recipes and tech-niques for making shells and fillings for macarons so that they can continue to experiment outside the classroom.

2025 4-H Summer Day Camp Registration

Go to the St. Johns County 4-H Website at <http://sfyl.ifas.ufl.edu/stjohns/4-h-youth-development/> and click on 4-H Events and Activities to see the summer camps. Registration opens March 18th to the public (non-4-H members).

All non-4-Hers will be required to register as a **youth participant** in 4-H Online when registering for a camp. This allows camp leaders to have health, contact and allergy information. Be sure your child is the **correct 4-H age** for each camp they register for. **4-H age is determined by how old campers were on September 1, 2024 NOT their age at the time of the camp, unless otherwise noted.** Payment can be made by credit card online in 4honline. **Please note: there is a non-refundable processing fee if you are paying with a credit card.** If you want to pay by check, please contact the 4-H Office. Payment must be received by the 4-H office within five days after registration or the registration will be cancelled. Payment will not be accepted on the first day of camp.

Full refunds will be given if notice of cancellation is provided at least 14 days prior to the first day of camp. If payment is made by credit card, the processing fee is not refundable. Refunds do NOT include Clover Awards. Clover Awards will be reimbursed in August, after parent has paid for camp and youth has attended.

* Camp registration will be posted on the St. Johns County 4-H website on **March 18th** for the public (non-4-H members) to register. **Click camp link, click register, enter email address & click "Email Login Link" to receive a registration link to your email.**

2025 4-H Summer Day Camp Information

Youth registering for camps agree to allow photos taken to be used for promotional purposes.

Attire should be 4-H appropriate:

- Shirt straps must be at least 2" wide. (no spaghetti, halter, muscle, cut-off, or tube tops)
- Shorts must be no more than 4" above the knee
- No offensive or inappropriate language, graphics, or logo t-shirts
- No holes in clothing (shirts or pants/shorts)
- No pajamas and no low-cut pants or shirts
- Closed toe shoes are required
