



SLC 4-H CLOVER CLUB'S FREE LITTLE LIBRARY PROJECT

On Friday, May 10, 2024, the Clover 4-H Club held a ribbon-cutting ceremony to commemorate the completion of the area's newest Little Free Library. The Clover Club is a homeschool club, and what is one thing all homeschoolers have in common? Books! The combination of a love of books and the 4-H commitment to community service paired for a perfect project in the Little Free Library. Club President Gabriel Pilch stated, "My favorite part of the Little Free Library was how it all came together when everybody worked together." This Little Free Library is the first to be built by any 4-H club in St. Lucie County.

The design chosen for the Little Free Library is a light green background with dark green clovers painted by each member and commemorated with the names of each 2023-2024 club member. Club Vice President Ava Schildmeier said, "I think the design chosen for the Little Free Library represents our club in many ways." The Clover Club worked diligently all year to bring this project to completion. Club Leader Lydia Pilch summed it up, "So today, we get to celebrate the culmination of hard and intentional work from a huge variety of willing people. And every time we look at the library, we can remember the efforts of our 4-H community that made this possible. The heads that had so many creative ideas, the hearts that wanted to be a blessing to those around them, the hands that gave to larger service to their community, and the health that everyone who takes a book from this library will receive in the benefits of reading good books." This new resource was constructed at the UF/IFAS Hurricane House at 8350 Picos Road, Fort Pierce, Florida, and is registered on the Little Free Library website.

Exhibitor Entry Fee: A \$25.00 entry fee for each project will be due upon registration and no later than August 9, 2024. This entry fee helps to cover the cost of the tree and the starting supplies






