UF/IFAS Extension Wakulla County 4-H Summer Day Camp programs along with Family Consumer Sciences activities will start June 12, 2023 and continue through August 3, 2023. **There will NOT be any camp the week of July 3rd – 8th.** Each week will have a different theme. The programming is structured to promote learning and creativity. Campers will experience learning through hands on activities and instruction. Update may require approval for you to proceed to camp registration. Approvals will be done within 24 business hours.
- New enrollees will need to create an account and profile as a participant.

- Once you have created or updated your profile, you will find the camps listed under **Events** in the left-hand column of the page. You will register for each week of camp individually. Please check camp names and dates to assure you are registering for the correct camp week.
- Once you have registered for camps, you will receive an approval notice by email. Please do not attempt to make deposits or payments until you have received an approval notice.
- A deposit is required for 4-H camps only to hold a slot for each camp week.
- FCS requires full payment to hold a slot for each camp.

All payments should be made at the Wakulla County Extension Office, 84 Cedar Avenue, Crawfordville, FL, 32327. The office is open Monday – Friday 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
