Wakulla 4-H 2024-2025** Annual Sponsorship Levels

Wakulla 4-H serves youth in the local community. The 4-H program year runs from September 1 to August 31. During the year, 4-H sends youth to camps, competitions, and special events. Wakulla 4-H is the larger organization that supports individual 4-H community clubs with supplies and equipment. 4-H bears the cost of screening and training adult volunteers to support youth activities. Adult volunteers and the 4-H staff team receive training opportunities to provide enhanced youth programming throughout the year. 4-H is open to all youth, regardless of financial circumstances. With that in mind, our supporters engage in fundraising efforts to help make 4-H participation possible for as many youths as possible.

Sponsors may request that funds support a specific club, scholarship opportunity to expand access to 4-H, special 4-H activity or event, or be used for general 4-H program support.

New this year: The Clover Gala will be held at the Wakulla Springs Lodge. Special thanks to the Wakulla Springs Lodge for their generous support of 4-H as a host sponsor.
